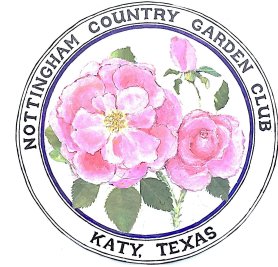


Nottingham Country Garden Club-March General Meeting
